


# DODGSON WOOD

*Farming and eco holidays*



**Dodgson Wood Campsite** is on the East side of Coniston Water and does not have a post code so please **don't rely on your Sat Nav for the final part of the journey.**

**When approaching from the South** use the postcode **LA12 8EF**, which will bring you to the Red Lion Inn at Lowick Bridge on your left.

As you approach the pub turn **RIGHT** at the cross roads, go over the bridge and turn **LEFT** onto the East of Lake road, follow this road for approx 4 miles.

You will pass a couple of farms and drive through the village of Nibthwaite. You will then see the lake on your left. Continue for approx 1 mile until you see a jetty out into the lake and a gate on the right with a green sign on it saying Farm Access Only. This is the entrance to the campsite. It is padlocked so you will need to climb over the gate to find the key safe, which is on the wooden fencing of the sheep pens. Once through the gate, please padlock the gate before driving up the track. Keep the key as this will also open the compost toilet locks. Drive up the track into the wood for around 300m and you will find the site.

**When approaching from the North** use the postcode **LA21 8AD** which will bring you to Brantwood. Drive straight past Brantwood and continue on the same road for approx 2 miles.

You will pass a few car parks but Dodgson Wood car park is the last one before Nibthwaite and is located where the road is very close to the lake. Go past the car park and continue for about 300m and you will see a wooden gate on your **LEFT** with a green sign on it saying Farm Access Only. This is the entrance to the campsite. It is padlocked so you will need to climb over the gate to find the key safe, which is on the wooden fencing of the sheep pens. Once through the gate, please padlock the gate before driving up the track. Keep the key as this will also open the compost toilet locks. Drive up the track into the wood for around 300m and you will find the site.
